## **House Alcohol Rules**

As a valued organization in the Chalk River community, we are dedicated to our patrons' pleasure and satisfaction. However, when it comes to the sale and service of alcohol, by law, we will not permit drunkenness. Nor will we serve patrons who are troublesome, dangerous or under the legal drinking age.

To support this position, these are our house alcohol rules. Please do your best to abide by them:

1. We will not tolerate any fighting or vandalism. Customers who do either will be asked to leave.
2. Drinking or smoking, on the dance floor or in the washrooms are not permitted.
3. At the entrance and on the floor, Lions Club volunteers are on duty to check ID, deny entry to rowdy or intoxicated persons and prevent overcrowding.
4. Other than Special Occasion permit events, many of our events are restricted to persons 19 years and older. For these "age of majority" events, please carry your ID with you.
5. Volunteer staff will assist customers to drink safely. Volunteer staff will not serve customers to the point of intoxication nor will they serve customers who are already intoxicated.
6. The law strictly prohibits the use or sale of illegal drugs.
7. Intoxicated customers or those who start fights, damage property or bother other customers will be dealt with carefully and politely.

For your information:

1. We offer a low cost snacks and often, a light meal.
2. We offer low priced non-alcohol beverages.
3. A taxi service is available. Please ask the volunteer staff for assistance.

All our volunteer staff have been trained in the legal and safe service of alcohol. They recognize signs of intoxication and will intervene to keep patrons safe and sober.
