McGill University in Montreal, in collaboration with the Jewish General Hospital in Montreal, the Washington University in St. Louis School of Medicine and the Barnes Jewish Hospital in Washington, formulated this [online chronic disease risk factor screening tool](#). This screening tool consists of several questionnaires evaluating risk factors for several different types of cancer. In a final report, the participants overall level of risk is identified as are the individual risk factors for that person.
